Totton and Eling Christmas Lights

The Totton and Eling Christmas trees and decorations will shortly be on display throughout the Town with the help of the Team Totton volunteers. Each year our costs are in excess of £3,000 (our insurance alone is over £600 just for the xmas period). There is no central Council funding and the committee rely on voluntary donations. This year we have had to replace 10 trees coupled with the electrical connectors (£1500). Throughout 2024 the volunteers have been busy: Christmas trees and figurines have been repaired; PAT testing has taken place; brackets have been checked; extra wiring and connectors prepared and checked. It's not just about putting the decorations up at the beginning of December, the volunteers have been busy all year using their individual skills.
